High-Speed Rail Authority Applauds Release of Prop1A Funds for Local Rail Improvements

SACRAMENTO, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority today applauded the California Transportation Commission’s approval of the release of Prop 1A funds of \$40 million for Caltrain’s advanced signaling system and \$61 million for the Central Subway’s extension of light rail.
