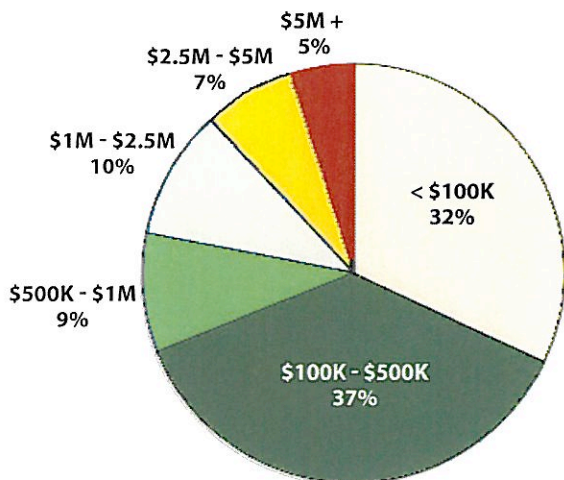


# THE NONPROFIT LANDSCAPE IN SAN MATEO COUNTY

## NONPROFITS BY BUDGET SIZE



Budgets cover business operations such as salaries, facilities, supplies and program expenses:

- 208 (32%) organizations have budgets under \$100,000
- 246 organizations (37%) have budgets between \$100,000 and \$500,000
- 169 nonprofits (26%) have budgets between \$500,000 and \$5 million
- Only 36 charities (5%) have annual budgets over \$5 million

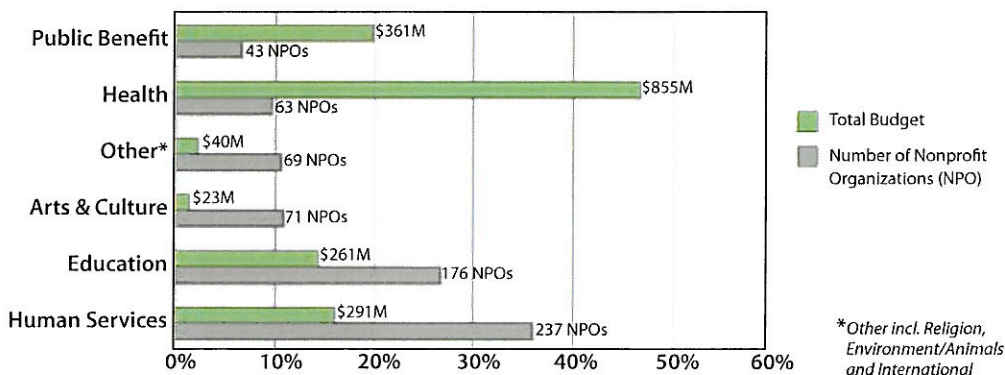
Charitable 501(c)(3) nonprofits are organizations that exist for the public good; they do not earn profits accruing to any individuals. In San Mateo County, 971 such organizations are active today:

- 312 foundations
- 235 human services agencies
- 424 other nonprofits
- Churches are not included
